Governance Charter

La Casa del Compadre – Unidos por la Comunidad

Article 1 – Founding Leadership

The Project *La Casa del Compadre – Unidos por la Comunidad* is established under the leadership of:

- **President**: Mr. Fredy Herman Morey Trigozo Founder and Chief Executive Officer of Morey Group, Project Creator and Legal Representative.
- Vice President: Mr. Simone Giglio
 Responsible for operational coordination and international development.
- Honorary President: Ms. Maria Antonia Sala Representative of cultural and ethical values, supporting the mission with symbolic and institutional authority.

Article 2 – Board of Directors

The Project shall be governed by a Board of Directors composed of at least five (5) members, entrusted with strategic and financial supervision. The current composition is as follows:

- Treasurer: Ms. Kimberly Pulley Responsible for financial management, accounting oversight, and compliance with applicable regulations.
- **Secretary**: Mr. Massimiliano Bettinaglio Responsible for documentation, internal communication, and governance procedures.
- Financial Advisor: Mr. Paolo Taurino
 Provides strategic financial advisory, investment guidance, and fund management support.

Article 3 – Committees and Operational Units

- 1. Ethical & Scientific Committee (to be established)
 - o Independent experts in education, healthcare, human rights, and sustainable architecture.
 - Ensures compliance with ethical standards and evaluates the social and humanitarian impact.
- 2. Fundraising & Partnerships Unit
 - Manages sponsorships, crowdfunding campaigns, institutional grants, and donor relations.

3. Local Coordination Units (Italy & Peru)

- Local managers responsible for:
 - *Italy*: Listening Centers, social integration programs, and community support.
 - *Peru*: Orphanages, shelters for single mothers, mobile health units, and training centers.

Article 4 – Governance Principles

The governance of La Casa del Compadre shall be guided by the following principles:

1. Transparency

- o Annual publication of financial statements and social impact reports.
- o Independent external audit of accounts and financial flows.

2. Accountability

- Regular reporting to donors, sponsors, and institutional partners.
- o Monitoring of Key Social Impact Indicators (KPI).

3. Inclusion & Participation

• Engagement of the Peruvian community in Italy and Peru in planning and decision-making processes.

4. Sustainability

- o Reinvestment of surpluses into the expansion of social programs.
- o Modular and replicable growth model based on recycled containers.

Article 5 – Future Development

By the year 2030, *La Casa del Compadre* shall establish the "La Casa del Compadre Foundation", as an independent legal entity under international non-profit law, ensuring:

- Long-term governance stability.
- Global expansion of the project.
- A permanent endowment fund to guarantee continuity of operations.
